When we meet on February 11th, Super Bowl LII (52) will be history and we will be in day four of the Winter Olympics from South Korea.

Like most people, I've been watching the Winter Olympics on TV for many years, the skiing, the jump skiing, the skating, speed and especially the figure skating. Looking back, there are two Olympics that stand out, 1980 and 1994.

The 1980 Olympics in Lake Placid New York was memorable because of the win of the US Men's Ice Hockey team over the Soviet Hockey Team, the "Miracle on Ice."

The 1994 Olympics in Lillehammer, Norway was memorable because of the opening ceremony and the famous confrontation between Tonya Harding and Nancy Kerrigan. The opening ceremony featured a skier playing a violin or fiddle, skiing down a hill and entering the arena. First Lady Hillary Clinton was present at Lillehammer. I recall she made some very nice comments about Norway and the Norwegian people.

The Lillehammer Olympics became the most watched in TV history because of the Tonya Harding and Nancy Kerrigan competition. Who can forget the drama: Tonya's shoe laces and her poor performance.

The 1994 Lillehammer Olympics was the second time that Norway has hosted the winter games. The 1952 games were held in Oslo, where Dick Buttons became a household name.

Norwegian athletics are among the best in the Winter Olympics. If you have not already, be sure to read the cover story in the current issue of the *Viking* magazine.
