While scrolls are found in this area's painting, they are secondary to the lush bouquets of stylized tulips, roses, daises, and leaves often surrounded with elegant roping, vases, drapery, and landscapes.

In this class a design will be offered as a point of departure to understand the characteristics classic to Valdres Rosemaling. The interplay of color and shape will be emphasized as we paint a 12" covered bowl with and exterior marbled border. A supply list will be sent out on or before April 2th for this class.
