She was especially proud to have created two Hardanger embroidered Alter cloths for First Lutheran Church. She won many recognitions for her beautiful Hardanger work. She loved sharing her Norwegian Heritage by baking lefse and Norwegian cookies for all.

Ruby is survived by a daughter, Lynda (Jim) Short and son Dale (Jeanine), 3 granddaughters, 4 great grandchildren, sister-in-law LaVern Haagensen and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband Donald and son Dennis, three sisters and three brothers.

Ruby's funeral was held on April 1 at First Lutheran Church.

MARIE S HALL, 88, died recently at her home in Manchester Township, Boone Co., Illinois. She was born on December 8, 1927, the daughter of Walter and Lena Zick. She attended a one room school and graduated from Capron High School. She received a two year degree from Rockford Career College.

There will be demonstrations of Hardanger embroidery, krumkake baking, as well as displays of Hardanger, Norwegian foods, Rosemaling, books and other artifacts. We expect to have Norwegian music and scenic DVDs of Norway also. Our display of Hardanger embroidery will stay in place till the end of the month. Come join us in sharing our Norwegian heritage with the Orfordville community.



Recipes

Norwegian Strawberries and Cream Cake (Bløtkake)

3/4 cake flour
6 eggs, separated

1 tsp baking powder
1 cup sugar

Filling:

3 egg yolks
2 tbsp. cornstarch
1/4 c sugar
1/2 c strawberry or apricot jam, warmed and strained
1 pint fresh strawberries

2 tbsp. butter
1 1/2 c half-and-half
2 tsp vanilla extract

Topping:

1 1/2 c whipping cream
1 tsp vanilla
2 tbsp. powdered sugar

Blend flour with baking powder; set aside. In large bowl, whip egg whites until fluffy; gradually add sugar, and beat until stiff and meringue-like. In small bowl, beat egg yolks until frothy. Fold egg yolks and flour mixture into the egg whites. Butter two 9-inch round cake pans and dust with flour. Divide batter between pans.

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Bake layers 30 minutes or until centers spring back when touched with finger. Cool in pans. (Centers of cakes may sink slightly). To prepare the custard filling, in small saucepan, mix egg yolks, butter, cornstarch, half-and-half, and sugar. Cook, stirring, over medium heat until mixture is smooth and thick. Remove from heat, cover, and cool. Stir in vanilla.

To assemble the cake, cut layers horizontally into 2 layers each. Place bottom layer on cake plate and spread with half of the custard. Top with next layer. Spread with the strawberry or apricot jam. Reserve a few of the nicest strawberries for garnish on top of the cake. Spread with remaining custard. Top with remaining layer of cake and put whipped cream over all. Garnish with whole berries.
