The 2016 Lindebrekke Family Trip to Norway

The 2016 Lindebrekke family trip to Norway began in Oslo. We then traveled via Kristiansand, on the south coast, to Preikestolen (Pulpit Rock), on the Lysefjord. We visited four family farms of our great grandparents: Ferkingstad on Karmøy island (Rogaland), Jordal in Odda, and Lindebrekke and Håheim in Ulvik on the Hardanger Fjord (Hordaland). We visited five stavkirke: Borgund, Kaupanger, Røldal, Undredal, and Urnes; and spent time in Voss, Bergen, Flåm, Hafslo, the Jostedal Glacier and Nærøysfjord (Sognefjord)
