

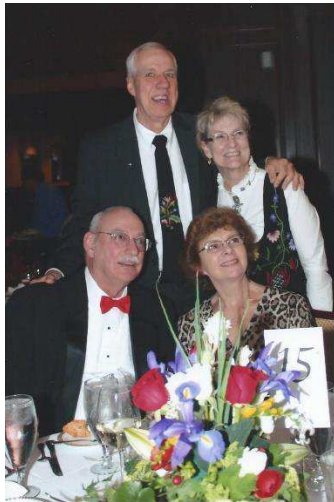

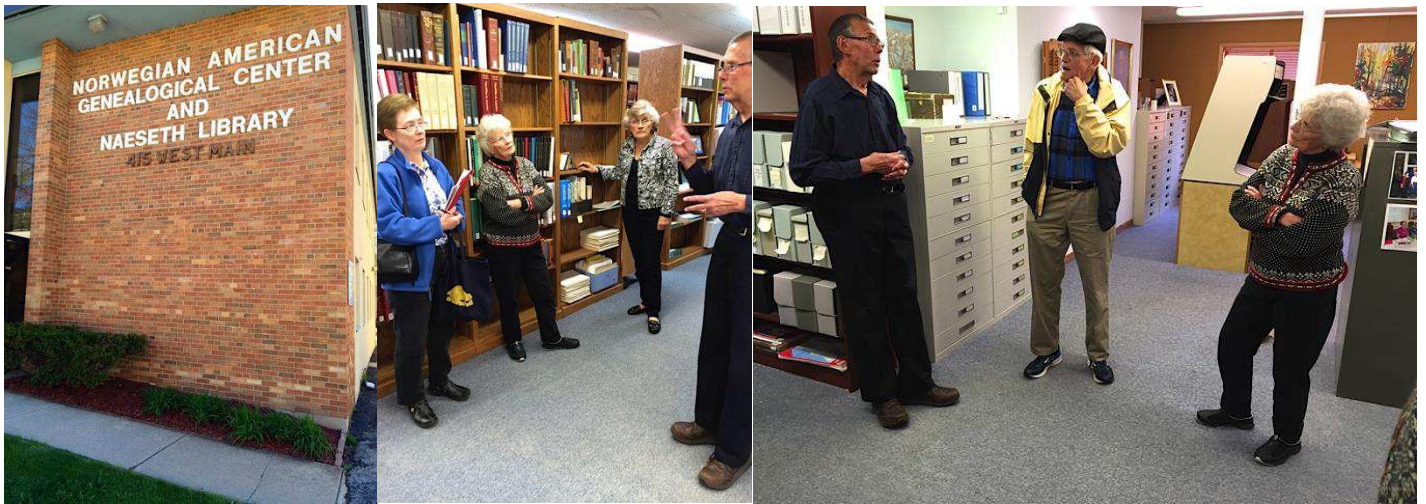

POLAR STAR FIELD TRIP DEADLINES APPROACHING.....



Editor's note....Revisiting articles written by Nancy Andersen and Carol Devito **from the May 2016 Newsletter that led to the scheduling of our 2017 Polar Star Field Trip:**

Did you think you would have to go to North Dakota or Norway to do research on your family roots? The Norwegian American Genealogical Center and Naeseth Library is an amazing resource right in Madison, Wisconsin near UW campus. We were amazed at their collection of bygdeboks (local Norwegian record books, including farm information) and many other resources. They also have obtained online access to databases in Norway. Something that really sets them apart is that they also offer translation assistance and expert, in-house research assistance (for a fee). The fees are reduced for members, and basic membership is just \$40 per year. Go to their website (www.nagcnl.org) and check out what they have to offer. Be sure to watch their fine, short videos. (submitted by Nancy Andersen)

Just recently the Livsreise-Norwegian Heritage Center opened. I have an information letter from the manager of the center. The center tells the story of Norwegian immigration to the Midwest from 1825 to 1920, when 800,000 people left Norway for a new life. They house a combination of historic artifacts along with electronic and interactive displays, immigrant storybooks, and a large "map wall" where visitors can build a sample immigrant journey. They also have another small gallery housing the "Sacred Symbols of Norway" exhibit on loan from the Vesterheim Museum in Decorah, Iowa. There is also a small genealogy lab where you can research your family lineage.

The town is fun to explore. It has many specialty shops and, of course, a bakery, And Stoughton is the home of The Sons of Norway Mandt Lodge #314. (Submitted by Carol Devito)
