Tubfrim History and information.

Postmaster Ditlef Frantzen in Nesbyen established TUBFRIM in 1928. The aim was to collect and sell used stamps and use the proceeds to aid the eradication of tuberculosis among Norwegian children. The first profit was made in 1929 and amounted to NOK 1.500. TUBFRIM is owned by the Norwegian Health Association (Nasjonalforeningen for folkehelsen). Today the profits are used to help handicapped children and youth in Norway, and to finance the efforts to eradicate tuberculosis.

Used postage stamps and telephone cards are not to be thrown in the waste basket, but should be sent to: **Give to Sons of Norway members/lodges**

How to help us. Please, never throw away canceled stamps and phone cards. Stamps and phone cards from any country in the world can be used. Just cut or tear the stamps off the envelopes, leaving a slight margin (approx. 1/4 to 1/2 inch) to keep the perforation intact. Damaged stamps (damaged perforation, edges etc.) are worthless and are to be thrown away. (Damaged phonecards are also to be thrown away.)

We are also happy to receive stamp collections, old envelopes, covers and postcards. If envelopes, postcards etc. are more than 50 years old, then please do not cut off the stamp, but send us the whole envelope/postcard!

Tubfrim winner announced



Sons of Norway is very excited to announce that Trollheim 1-511 in St. Cloud, MN is the winner of the Tubfrim drawing to give away a ticket to Norway, worth up to \$1,000. Their postcard was drawn from among 876 cards. With one card for every pound of stamps sent to Norway, that means that Sons of Norway sent at least 876 pounds or approximately 1,314,000 stamps to Tubfrim in 2018. During this past year, 73 lodges participated in the program.

What is Tubfrim?

Tubfrim was established in 1928 by Postmaster Ditlef Frantzen in Nesbyen, Norway. The purpose of the program was to collect and sell used stamps and use the proceeds to aid in the eradication of tuberculosis among Norwegian children. Since tuberculosis is no longer the threat to health that it once was, today children and youth with disabilities and special needs receive the proceeds from the resale of the stamps. Sons of Norway has been involved with the organization since 1986 and is its major contributor of stamps from a group outside of Norway.

Win a Ticket to Norway

While helping children is a great motivation for Sons of Norway members to participate, there is a special incentive to say "thank you." For every pound of stamps collected, the member or lodge can enter a drawing to win a round trip ticket to Norway, worth up to \$1,000. The drawing is held at the beginning of the year for the previous year,

Credit Card Affinity Program Discontinued



Sons of Norway recently received notice from one of

our partners, U.S. Bank, that they are terminating our affinity credit card program and trademark license agreement due to shifting the business model for their affinity programs. U.S. Bank will include a statement message for six months, notifying existing cardholders that their card will no longer support Sons of Norway. Sons of Norway will also inform our members through our appropriate communication platforms.

Please share this information with your lodge members:

- The U.S. Bank VISA credit card affinity program ends April 30, 2019.
- On May 1, 2019, U.S. Bank will close the web channel and no longer accept applications for the Sons of Norway program.
- By May 1, 2019, Sons of Norway will remove U.S. Bank from its website.
- U.S. Bank will stop sending any communication to existing cardholders.
- U.S. Bank will not reissue plastics, however, when cards come up for natural reissue, they will get a bank branded card (U.S. Bank logo).


