
Friendly Fifth Friday News August 11, 2017

<u>D63 – Officer Election Report- Set your officer election date now!</u>

Each year the D63 (Officer Election Report) is due on December 15. This report is either emailed or mailed to the lodge secretary from the International office.

I encourage lodges to set their officer election date now and to insure that it is done by December 15 so the report can be filed on time. We are going into a convention year so the sooner I have the directory done, the sooner that we can start the delegate and other processes.


So if your election is usually in December but that's your Christmas party or your meeting date is after the 15th, then I encourage you to elect in November. Please don't wait until January meetings!

If your lodge does not elect officers this year, the report still needs to be filed!! You can do this online or send in the form and check the box (no changes) and that's all you have to do! But you HAVE to file it.

Please don't start reporting officer elections yet (wait until the International sends out their materials in October)- I just wanted to get the topic on your lodge agendas and your nominating committees started so all elections can take place before December 15 so we can get ALL lodges reporting on time!

There are resources on the website about officer positions if you need for newsletters. I can send you some as well that we use at Mandt Lodge. The use of a nominating committee is crucial for helping to solicit candidates for offices. The make up of that committee may vary from lodge to lodge but on your August and September agendas, the nominating committee should be selected or identified so they may begin their work. If you need help downloading membership lists or other resources, please let me know!

From Madison via Interstate:

Go east from Madison going towards Chicago on the Interstate 39-90. Exit 147 on Hwy N and turn right. Go about 2-3 miles and you will come to a 4-way stop. Turn left on Skaalen Road and go about 1½ miles. We are the first long drive way on the left after you pass the housing development. We have a Norwegian farm sign at the end of the driveway.

From Madison via Hwy 51:

Go south on Hwy 51 from Madison, through McFarland and almost to Stoughton. Before you get to town, take a left on Hwy B by the Evergreen State Bank. Stay on Hwy B until you come to the 4-way stop sign at Hwy B and Hwy N (the county garage will be on your left). Go straight and the road turns into Skaalen Rd. Go about 1 ½ miles. We are the first long drive way on the left after you pass the housing development. We have a Norwegian farm sign at the end of the driveway.

From Oregon: (2 options)

- ✓ Come to Stoughton on Hwy 138. You can go all the way through town on Main Street and continue out of town on Hwy 51. After about 1 ½ miles, turn left on Pleasant Hill Road. Come to a t-intersection with Skaalen Rd, take a right and we're the first long drive way to the left. We have a Norwegian farm sign at the end of the driveway.
- ✓ **Or** when you come into Stoughton on Hwy 138, take a left on Hwy 51. Go out to Hwy B and take a right on Hwy B (by Evergreen State Bank). Stay on Hwy B until you come to the 4-way stop sign at Hwy B and Hwy N (the county garage will be on your left). Go straight and the road turns into Skaalen Rd. Go about 1 ½ miles. We are the first long drive way on the left after you pass the housing development. We have a Norwegian farm sign at the end of the driveway.

From the South (Janesville):

Starting April 21st, the I-39/90 northbound ramp, Exit #156 at the US 51 interchange for Coachman's will be closed until August 1, 2017. Please use Exit #160 for Hwy 73. Left off exit, take a right onto Albion Road/Cty A. Coachmans will be located 4 miles up.

Go about 2 miles and take a right on Pleasant Hill Road. Come to a t-intersection with Skaalen Rd, take a right and we're the first drive way to the left.
