2023 District 5 Lodge New Member Recruitment Contest

Sons of Norway District 5 is pleased to announce the launch of our 2023 recruitment campaign.

Starting August 1, 2023, all lodge members are asked to recruit new members to their local lodge. For every new member (not Heritage Member) recruited, the lodge will receive \$10 for an individual or \$20 for a family membership. This does not include adding adults to an existing Adult Family membership. The money awarded will be sent to the local lodge of the recruiting member to be used as the lodge would like.

This campaign is an opportunity for all members to get involved and support their local lodge in meeting their membership goals. As well, it helps continue to grow the Sons of Norway organization.

The contest will begin August 1, 2023 and go until October 31, 2023.

Please turn in all paper membership applications to Headquarters by October 31, 2023. This will ensure that they are processed by the deadline. New members who are signed up online via http://www.sofn.com should also be entered by October 31, 2023.



Have a recruitment event coming up? Like to be ready to encourage new members? The website is ready! Take a peek at the different things you can do with the red "Join/Renew" button in the upper right-hand corner of the website.

First, **new** members can sign up with the "Join" button. Potential members have the option to find a lodge or join the Central Lodge. Depending on location and number of lodges, potentials can select a lodge to join instantly online or contact for more information.

The second button helps to **renew or re-activate a membership**. There is the option to pay monthly (from a checking account) or annually (from a credit card.) It is important to have your seven-digit membership number for this step.

The third button helps to **add household members** to your existing membership. You will need the new member's birthdate with the year for this step and an email address is helpful.

A last note, membership forms are available to download from the website (there is a <u>US form</u> and a <u>Canada and Norway form</u>), if you prefer hardcopy forms. Some events may be outside or in areas without Wi-Fi, so online access may not be available. As things move away from paper, it's important to consider how to embrace online efficiencies. Please note: Headquarters will soon discontinue printing and mailing out enrollment forms. Lodges who still want to hand out paper applications can download the forms from the site and print them locally.
