

Helping Hands to Members Grant Guidelines

The Sons of Norway Foundation Helping Hands to Members Grants are offered for up to \$1,000 to provide assistance to current Sons of Norway members whose homes are significantly damaged and are deemed unlivable for a period of time due to a natural disaster. Such disasters include floods, wild fires, hurricanes, tornados and other catastrophes.

Who is eligible?

To qualify you must be a current member of Sons of Norway for at least one year. The property in question must be your primary residence.

How are grant recipients selected?

The Foundation will make final decisions based on assessments of loss and the level of financial support available from the Humanitarian Fund of the Sons of Norway Foundation. In a large disaster, the Foundation may appoint one person in the affected area to coordinate information.

What are the requirements?

Current Sons of Norway members may apply for a Helping Hands to Members Grant by contacting their Lodge President, Zone Director, District President or the Sons of Norway Foundation.

Please provide photo(s), your FEMA number and a brief statement by a person, other than immediate family, (ideally the Lodge President) to confirm the damage to your home. These items may be scanned and faxed to 612-827-0658, e-mailed to foundation@sofn.com or mailed to Sons of Norway Foundation, 1455 West Lake St., Minneapolis, MN 55408. You may be visited by a representative of Sons of Norway to assess your needs.

Helpful information:

If you are a victim of a natural disaster, please keep us posted with your temporary address, e-mail address and current telephone number so we may reach you.
