Each year the D63 (Officer Election Report) is due on December 15. This report is either emailed or mailed to the lodge secretary from the International office.

If your lodge does not elect officers this year, the report still needs to be filed!! You can do this online or send in the form and check the box (no changes) and that's all you have to do! But you HAVE to file it.

Sons of Norway Headquarters is pleased to announce the launch of its 2017 recruitment campaign – a revamped and expanded Founders Day Awards. With our 125th anniversary fast approaching, the new campaign reinforces the vision of Sons of Norway's founders for an organization that provides mutual support for its members and celebrates its roots while continuing to look toward the future.

The Growing to 2020 campaign comes from the 2017 goals established by the Sons of Norway International Board of Directors, which are:

Frequently Asked Questions

What constitutes a new member?

A new member is anyone who has not been a member within the last two years and is over the age of 16.

What about members who leave the lodge?

The challenge is only concerned with recruitment, meaning it doesn't take into consideration whether your lodge has lost members. For example, if your lodge membership was 70 on January 1, your lodge goal is 7 new members.

What is the time frame?

Lodges will have from January 1 through December 31 to recruit new members, but they will need to be processed by Sons of Norway Headquarters in 2017 to qualify.

What about small lodges?

As a whole, Sons of Norway only succeeds when we all work together. In that spirit, lodges with less than 50 members are being challenged to recruit 5 members.

How can a lodge track its progress?

First, your lodge will need its membership total from the end of 2016. To keep track moving forward, check with your lodge secretary. They receive a monthly report with the number of new members joining the lodge.
