International Convention and Convention Cycle Update

Headquarters is planning for the International Convention. They are also helping our eight districts by reviewing the hotel contracts. In addition, they want to ensure that contingency plans are in effect if COVID-19 causes SofN to cancel its convention. The International Convention's contract language is being reviewed for any financial implications that a cancellation could cause. Decisions have not been made regarding any on-site COVID-19 protocols that could be required. Connie O'Brien, Director of Fraternal Development and Marketing, indicated that town hall discussions would be scheduled with district leaders to garner further input.

There have been discussions on how to handle virtual voting. Dave Ness (SofN legal counsel) is integral to these discussions. Several programs options exist.

The 2022 International Convention will have a shortened meeting time with delegates. In addition, our members will have more activities that center on cultural or heritage programming. These changes are being driven by the transition to a different governance structure. Delegates will handle fewer of the business decisions for the financial side of the SofN. Instead, an elected board of directors will be taking on that role.

Other topics could include planning for an exciting lodge year, engaging the membership in a lodge, and offering additional programming for members by virtual and in-person meetings. If you have ideas on what kind of breakout sessions would be helpful, please share these with me. I will be working with Connie to plan a meaningful convention for our members.
