It's time to start thinking about Masse Moro!

Dear 2019 Masse Moro Campers, Parents, Sponsors, Staff, Volunteers and Friends:

I would like to wish you a wonderful and happy 2020! Our 2019 Masse Moro camp was a terrific experience thanks to all of you and to our wonderful staff. We were privileged to have campers come from ten different states and two staff members from Norway. Thirty six campers of our fifty three were sponsored and received scholarships from Lodges throughout District 1 and District 5.

To all of our 2019 Masse Moro graduates, we thank you for participating and we look forward to your continued support for Masse Moro 2020.

Our Masse Moro camp will be held for the 41st time this summer from **July 12 – 25, 2020** at the beautiful, rustic Beaver Creek Reserve in Fall Creek, Wisconsin.

As you may realize, our expenses for camp have increased, but thanks to our Sons of Norway District 5 Board, I am pleased to inform you that we have only increased our tuition by \$50.00. The 2020 tuition for two weeks of exploring your Norwegian heritage through crafts, music, language class, Olympics, great food and meeting wonderful friends and counselors is only **\$850.00** compared to similar programs that cost over \$2000.00.

We appreciate the assistance of our Masse Moro campers, graduates, parents, staff, volunteers and sponsors to spread the word and encourage others to attend Masse Moro and experience "lots of fun" at camp. "Word of Mouth" is a terrific recruitment tool, so spread the word to your siblings, relatives, friends and neighbors who are from 9 to 15 years old to join us at camp.

Remind them that you do not have to be Norwegian to join us for lots of fun. In addition, they do not have to be a Sons of Norway member (but it sure helps). Check with your local Lodge or the Lodge of their relative for financial support.

To employ our very talented staff, I would encourage you to mail your application along with your \$50 deposit by **April 1, 2020**. By applying early, I will be able to secure our staff at a more reasonable time. Masse Moro is a very special experience, in large part, due to our dedicated, loyal, proficient staff. To insure that our staff returns, I would like to offer them their positions earlier rather than later; so I can do that if our campers apply early. Therefore, please go to www.massemoro.org and apply as soon as possible (only 60 positions are available).

Again Tusen Takk to all of our 2019 Masse Moro graduates, volunteers, staff and friends; we look forward to the return of our campers for an exciting Nordic heritage experience this summer at Masse Moro 2020!

The Sarah L. Paulsen Memorial Scholarship Fund.

The Rules

In August 1995 eight year old Sarah Paulsen of our lodge passed away.

Because Sarah was very involved with the Sons of Norway, and was fascinated with her family's background and with Norwegian culture, friends and family, along with the Scandiana Lodge felt a scholarship established in Sarah's name would be appropriate.

The scholarship will not only carry on her love for the Norwegian Heritage, but will also enable other children to have the opportunity to attend the Sons of Norway Heritage Camp in Eau Claire, in honor of Sarah.

The scholarship will cover one quarter of the camp cost.

Parents may be concerned that getting this scholarship would prevent them from utilizing the District 5 Matching Fund Grant, but this award will have no bearing on other matching funds. This scholarship could be given in addition to District 5 and Local Lodge Matching Fund Scholarships. However, if the applicant's Local Lodge is financially unable to give their children Matching Fund Scholarships, the Sarah Paulsen Scholarship would qualify them for the District 5 Matching Fund Scholarship.

Rules:

1. The scholarship is open to any child age 9-15, who is interested in learning about the language and culture of Norway.
2. The applicant must be a heritage member or a child or grandchild of a Sons of Norway member, and belonging to a District 5 Lodge.
3. The applicant will write an essay of no more than 500 words. The topic is "Why I believe it is important to know about our heritage" or "Why I want to attend Norwegian Heritage Camp".
4. All applicants will complete a brief application form.
5. Applicant will include 2 letters of reference, including one from a local Lodge officer.
6. Applications must be postmarked by April 15. Decisions will be made by May 1, and winners will be notified by mail. Checks will be issued and mailed directly to the Scholarship Recipient before June 1.
7. Judges will be the Scandiana 600 Sarah L Paulsen Memorial Scholarship Fund Committee.

Darlene Arneson, president of Mandt lodge in Stoughton, just laughed when I once asked her "If someone keeps coming to lodge activities and won't become a member, what do you do?"

Darlene said, "I figure that sooner or later, they will find enough value in what we are doing for them that they will JUST JOIN... Even if they don't, we are still fulfilling our lodge's mission to share our Nordic heritage with our community..."

"There are lots of people in Dane County who come to our heritage workshops, watch Norwegian interest movies here, enjoy buying Norwegian foods, and even play bingo, who aren't members..." Then she paused and said, "YET."

For me, one of the benefits of being involved in District Five is in networking with key leaders of successful lodges, learning and sharing the secrets of their success. Our lodge's old policy was "visit twice, join up or don't attend." After sharing Darlene's viewpoint, our lodge dropped this old policy which helped us become more welcoming.

Maybe Darlene didn't directly say it, but she challenged me to keep asking myself and my fellow lodge officers "Is our lodge offering enough value to prospective members so that they want to join? Are we fulfilling our promise to our members, so they want to continue to belong? Are we doing everything we can to share our Nordic heritage with our community?"
