If your lodge already has a Banner that meets these specifications, please bring it to the Convention. Three prizes will be given based on convention attendees votes.

- 1) 'People's Choice Over All' gift card (monetary amount to be determined)
- 2) 2 'Honorable Mention' [one for Commercial and one Lodge/hand made] gift card (monetary amount to be determined)


Banner Specifications

- 1) Suggested Size between 2 ft x 3 ft up to 3 ft x 6 ft.
- 2) Hang banner vertically on a 1" diameter wood dowel with 2 eye screws (one on each end) for hanging purposes.
- 3) A Base stand to hang the banner
- 4) Material: Any material except paper (drapery fabric works well).
- 5) Lodge name appears somewhere on the banner
- 6) Banner theme relates to the individual lodge.
- 7) Banners can be made in any color.
- 8) Banners will belong to their lodge, but will be displayed throughout the District Convention.

Masse Moro gives our young people that Nordic Experience that they will cherish for a life time.

We are delighted to announce that Zachary Garner and Keir Kristiansen will be returning again as our Masse Moro Co-Directors.

We are looking for a maximum of 60 to 65 campers, so to help us better plan for a super camp experience we encourage registrations early or by April 1st.

The dates for camp this year are **July 12 – 25**. The cost for this two week camp experience is only \$850 per camper compared to similar programs that run over \$2000.

There are many opportunities for campers to lower their cost for camp, please check them out.

Early Bird Benefits: Early registrants get a better chance at scholarships and lodge matching funds, so register by April 1st. Registration and Supporting forms can be found at www.massemoro.org or at the District 5 website.

Bring A Friend: Campers can bring a new camper and they will both receive \$25 off your tuition (both registrations and the total cost for camp must be postmarked by April 1, 2020 to receive this benefit).

Get Your Match: Campers are encouraged to check with their local lodge for supporting scholarships. To receive the matching funds (up to \$150) from District 5 campers must complete all paperwork by May 17th. All campers from other Districts, should check with their local lodges for Grants and Scholarships.

Have you shared information about Masse Moro with your school district?

It would be a really great opportunity to try to connect with the schools, especially in towns that have a strong Norwegian connection, and see if they would be willing to share materials with their students.


Schools will send notices concerning summer programming home with their students, so would it be possible for you or someone with connections in your Lodges to reach out to the schools. This could be a great opportunity to get the word out in an inexpensive way (perhaps free?). Some schools print or send home materials with kids ALL THE TIME."

If this would be something that you think would be workable, we would recommend sending home with the students a copy of the Masse Moro book marks or half sheets that are on our Masse Moro website http://www.massemoro.org. This outreach tool would be given to grade levels that fall between within our age requirement for Masse Moro.

A suggestion to get your foot in the school door would be for the Lodge Youth Director or President explain that they are promoting a specialty summer camp, Masse Moro, which is geared to our Nordic Heritage. They could ask if it would be possible or appropriate to share a flyer to send home with students in the grades 3 through 9; or ask for other suggestions.

If you aren't sure who to start with at a school, start with the school administrator and ask what the district's policy is for distributing information!




