#### Background

Interest in the Norwegian language and family history consistently rank as top interests among Sons of Norway members. Often these two interests intersect – in order to understand many genealogical records or to read old documents like family letters, the Norwegian-American genealogist must have some knowledge of the Norwegian language.

Learning Norwegian is never easy, however, especially for adult learners who may not have access to university extension programs. Even those who are lucky enough to study in a classroom often find that their instruction in modern standard Norwegian is not always useful for understanding older documents or texts written in the minority language form. That's why this course was created.

Louis Janus, the primary author of this program, is an accomplished linguist and life-long student of Norwegian. The idea for this course was inspired by his experience teaching students at the University of Minnesota to read modern Norwegian, Swedish and Danish simultaneously. Through his years of experience, Janus developed a unique approach for teaching students of one language to read similar languages. Here, the same formula has been used to help you understand the several forms of Norwegian that have evolved over the last century and a half.

If you've been craving new fitness goals, help is here! The following two medals have been added for anyone who aims to set the bar a little higher.

First, **Idrettshelt** [*ee-dretts-hellt*] –the sports hero pin– is the 5<sup>th</sup> level within any sports medal category.

Members must have completed the bronze, silver, gold and enamel pins in a sport category prior to starting on the *Idrettshelt*.

Earn double the point or mileage value of the **enamel** level to qualify for an *ldrettshelt* pin. Tracking cards for this medal may be requested from your lodge sports director. Record your mileage or minutes and return the card to your sports director to receive your pin.



Next is **Hederspris** [*hay-dersh-prees*], the outstanding achievement award. This pin is for members who've earned bronze, silver, gold and enamel medals in any **three** sports medal categories.
