There are some items that need to be approved and done at the official re-organization meeting and we handled that Monday night (mileage, meal expenses, printing reimbursement, signature cards).

But the highlights!

- The members had completed a survey to indicate their interest and needs for training. Board training will focus on lodge visits, hosting zone events, and hosting zone meetings and trainings.

- President Cheryl Wille-Schlesser shared her Lodge Assignments. With the addition of Sandra Olson, Sandra and Robert may discuss any changes in their assignments.
- Cheryl also had the committee assignments for board committees. There was discussion about having committee members serving who are not on the board. If anyone is interested, they should contact Cheryl.
- The task force that was approved at the June District Lodge meeting will be a priority for the biennium as we focus on how our board and zones are structured and what would be best for the members and lodges in our District.
- We are awaiting communication for the International Delegates about the virtual meeting.
