Romerikslag/Solorlag Stevne

The Romerikslag/Solorlag joint Stevne will be held Sept. 13-16, 2017 at The Hudson House in Hudson, WI. A Stevne is a gathering of people who have ancestral roots or present day ties to a certain area of Norway. Romerike is basically Akershus County in and around the Oslo area. Solor is part of Hedmark County in Norway. At this years Stevne you will enjoy a rich combination of presentations, such as, "In Trunks, Hands and Hearts", about what the Norwegian Immigrants brought with them to the United States. From Madison via Interstate:

Go east from Madison going towards Chicago on the Interstate 39-90. Exit 147 on Hwy N and turn right. Go about 2-3 miles and you will come to a 4-way stop. Turn left on Skaalen Road and go about 1 ½ miles. We are the first long drive way on the left after you pass the housing development. We have a Norwegian farm sign at the end of the driveway.

From Madison via Hwy 51:

Go south on Hwy 51 from Madison, through McFarland and almost to Stoughton. Before you get to town, take a left on Hwy B by the Evergreen State Bank. Stay on Hwy B until you come to the 4-way stop sign at Hwy B and Hwy N (the county garage will be on your left). Go straight and the road turns into Skaalen Rd. Go about 1 ½ miles. We are the first long drive way on the left after you pass the housing development. We have a Norwegian farm sign at the end of the driveway.

From Oregon: (2 options)

- ✓ Come to Stoughton on Hwy 138. You can go all the way through town on Main Street and continue out of town on Hwy 51. After about 1 ½ miles, turn left on Pleasant Hill Road. Come to a t-intersection with Skaalen Rd, take a right and we're the first long drive way to the left. We have a Norwegian farm sign at the end of the driveway.
- ✓ Or when you come into Stoughton on Hwy 138, take a left on Hwy 51. Go out to Hwy B and take a right on Hwy B (by Evergreen State Bank). Stay on Hwy B until you come to the 4-way stop sign at Hwy B and Hwy N (the county garage will be on your left). Go straight and the road turns into Skaalen Rd. Go about 1 ½ miles. We are the first long drive way on the left after you pass the housing development. We have a Norwegian farm sign at the end of the driveway.

From the South (Janesville):

Starting April 21st, the I-39/90 northbound ramp, Exit #156 at the US 51 interchange for Coachman's will be closed until August 1, 2017. Please use Exit #160 for Hwy 73. Left off exit, take a right onto Albion Road/Cty A. Coachmans will be located 4 miles up.

Go about 2 miles and take a right on Pleasant Hill Road. Come to a t-intersection with Skaalen Rd, take a right and we're the first drive way to the left. We have a Norwegian farm sign at the end of the driveway.

Some of these were being Municipal Judge, belonging to local organizations, VFW, American Legion, Sons of Norway, AFS, and more. In 2015 Ken was able to participate in the Badger Honor Flight out of Madison. Ken was honored and thrilled with the trip and felt blessed by the respect shown everywhere to him and the other veterans. In February, this year he was overjoyed when his AFS daughter Adelle and her husband Aren were able to visit from Guam. Then, in April Ken and family were able to have family photos taken. It was a beautiful day and Ken delighted in sitting and talking with everyone.
