## **Convention Update:**

The convention planning committee had a conference call tonight in which they reviewed the schedule, all the forms, and other related documents. There are a few changes to be made in them and we hope by mid-week to be able to send them out, post them, and get them to you. Thank you for your patience.

Here's the plan:

- Delegates- I have all but four lodges that have submitted their forms or information. Two have meetings coming up, one I'm waiting for a response, and one needed some more information. We have seven that aren't sending delegates.
- How will information be sent? Darlene Arneson will send out emails along with the FFFN. She
  will also send a hard copy of all documents to the Lodge Presidents and District Board. If your
  delegates don't have email, can't open the attachments, or don't want to print items- then the
  president and lodge can work out a way to get the information to them. Delegates will also get
  emails usually from Darlene. When those documents go out, Duane Kittleson will post them
  to the District website.
- Convention committees- Now that President Christianson has the delegate list, he will appoint his convention committees. The letter of invitation will come from Darlene Arneson and RSVP's will go back to her. The committees will meet on Thursday.
