SONS OF NORWAY DISTRICT PRESIDENTS' ADVISORY COUNCIL

VIRTUAL MEETING February 10, 2024

Districts are finding it difficult to form nominating committees. Most districts have a minimum of two individuals serving in this capacity, while others like District 5 have three or more members. Challenges that lie ahead are finding willing and qualified members to serve in key positions, especially those that require additional training or experience such as district treasurer. Once delegates have been elected for convention participation, the nominations committee will be able to begin their search in earnest.

Innovative ideas and new member participation keep our district vibrant and growing. If you are interested in serving as a zone director or would like to serve as a board director or officer, please let your wishes be known. This will make the task of our nominations committee much easier. Those who were elected to serve as our nominations committee are former D5 vice president, Kathy Secora, Zone 5, current vice president, Wendy Winkelman, Zone 6, and Mandt lodge member Janis Wegner, Zone 3. We can look at our present situation with a pessimistic view, or we can approach the future with the idea that all things are possible with help from our members. I prefer the second option.

Part of the challenge that nominations committees will face is the changing feel for the parent organization due to the myriad of changes and the lack of support that was once the standard. Local lodges feel disenfranchised.

No district will offer a Zoom alternative for their convention in 2024. The presidents shared that access to the lodge customer service department remains a challenge.

The home office is interested in more districts supporting the Sons of Norway Foundation. Districts were reminded that their revenue comes from membership dues, and it is appropriate to use these funds for donations to the Foundation. When the International Board chose to remove the 000 dues from each district, all districts lost a sizable amount of money from the coffers.

In the wind is an uptick in the cost of a yearly membership; this move will no doubt happen sooner rather than later. Keeping the company solvent is job one.

Due to changing and continuing updates from the International Board regarding by-law changes, districts are finding writing revisions a futile process. It is possible that by-law committees will need to return to the drawing board, and this has not been well received.

District three held a presentation for all lodge presidents and vice presidents regarding disbanding lodges. Ironically, those who needed this advisement were not present. The leadership from District 3 has suggested to all its lodges to consider a merger with another lodge rather than choosing disbandment. Distance meetings could be held via Zoom if the geographic distance is large. Kirsten Lehman from headquarters contributed to the program.

Lodge growth in District 2 continues with the largest lodge over two thousand members, another at 1400, and a third lodge's membership totals one thousand.

Members in District 1 spent considerable time with the Ski for Light event held in Rhinelander, WI. Minneapolis airport was chosen as the Welcome Committee. The 2025 event will be held in District 6. There has been no update on redistricting the Sons of Norway, so districts, like District 5 are in limbo with the resolution that recently passed. The District Presidents' Advisory Council has been asked for ideas on how to tackle issues, but the suggestions have little sway or outcome for the districts, lodges, or members. It is felt that the suggestions are ignored or passed over, and the fraternal aspect of our organization is lost. It is difficult for our most senior members to see the organization they built, and love being forever changed.

The District Presidents' Advisory Council has asked for a two-day work session this spring. It has not been determined whether this meeting will be scheduled.

The number of lodge members who have Sons of Norway products by district are provided below.

Note: Districts 7 and 8 must have a potential buyer visit a sales rep on U.S. soil to make a purchase. This has deterred sales in these districts. Since International conventions have been scrapped, these districts no longer have the need to require their delegates to purchase a product, and the number of insured in these regions will continue to decline. The only person who must carry a product will be the candidate for International Director from D7 and D8.

Sons of Norway District 5 will feature a **Norwegian artist of Sami heritage** at the 2024 convention in Indianapolis from June 19-22. **Jorn Magnus Rivojen Langseth** is well-known for his drums and other artistic pieces connected with the Ume Sami culture as well as interesting presentations advocating for Sami language preservation and describing Sami culture and history. He will give presentations on Sami culture, specifically regarding the significance of Sami drums. The presentations will include slides of his drums and other works of art ranging in size from large outdoor installations to small, exquisite knives. Langseth's passion about his Ume Sami heritage fuels his creativity and is expressed in his works to preserve the symbols, language, art, food — every aspect of the Sami culture. He shares his knowledge with others through art shows, personal appearances, and at the Umesamisk ressurssenteer in Norway. His art has been featured in shows throughout Norway and in other parts of the world. Arrangements are being made for Langseth's art to be displayed at Vesterheim Norwegian-American museum in Decorah, Iowa next year. Rivojen Art can be found on line for examples of Langseth's work. The Sarah L. Paulsen Memorial Scholarship Fund.

The Rules

In August 1995 eight year old Sarah Paulsen of our lodge passed away.

Because Sarah was very involved with the Sons of Norway, and was fascinated with her family's background and with Norwegian culture, friends and family, along with the Scandiana Lodge felt a scholarship established in Sarah's name would be appropriate.

The scholarship will not only carry on her love for the Norwegian Heritage, but will also enable other children to have the opportunity to attend the Sons of Norway Heritage Camp in Eau Claire, in honor of Sarah.

The scholarship will cover one quarter of the camp cost.

Parents may be concerned that getting this scholarship would prevent them from utilizing the District 5 Matching Fund Grant, but this award will have no bearing on other matching funds. This scholarship could be given in addition to District 5 and Local Lodge Matching Fund Scholarships. However, if the applicant's Local Lodge is financially unable to give their children Matching Fund Scholarships, the Sarah Paulsen Scholarship would qualify them for the District 5 Matching Fund Scholarship.

Rules:

- 1. The scholarship is open to any child age 9-15, who is interested in learning about the language and culture of Norway.
- 2. The applicant must be a heritage member or a child or grandchild of a Sons of Norway member, and belonging to a District 5 Lodge.
- 3. The applicant will write an essay of no more than 500 words. The topic is "Why I believe it is important to know about our heritage" or "Why I want to attend Norwegian Heritage Camp".
- 4. All applicants will complete a brief application form.
- 5. Applicant will include 2 letters of reference, including one from a local Lodge officer.
- 6. Applications must be postmarked by April 15. Decisions will be made by May 1, and winners will be notified by mail. Checks will be issued and mailed directly to the Scholarship Recipient before June 1.
- 7. Judges will be the Scandiana 600 Sarah L Paulsen Memorial Scholarship Fund Committee.
