Coming on Sunday afternoon June 2nd is THE FRIENDLY FIFTH FISHEREE! The event will be held weather permitting. The first weekend of June is free fishing weekend in Wisconsin. No licenses are required to fish, but laws in regard to catch limits must be observed. We do not allow any boats on the lake, so all fishing must be done from shoreline.

The rain date is Sunday, June 9th. View the District 5 Facebook page the morning of the event to determine whether there has been a cancellation before you leave home. A post will be made early in the morning that day, should weather be an impacting factor. If there is no post, the event will be held as planned.

All members in the District are welcome to attend. Grills will be available for cooking your family's favorite meats. Please bring a dish to pass, your own table service, and your preferred beverages. Dinner will be served at 12:30 PM. Please also supply garbage bags to carry out your refuse.

For your convenience, a porta-potty will be on-site! Bring whatever bait and tackle you wish to use. A pair of binoculars could be helpful for those who are birdwatchers. Bring lawn chairs for your comfort. Some tables will be available. Bug spray will be a necessity in this environment due to the wet spring weather and prime mosquito hatching season. If you are bringing little ones, a bug jar or butterfly net might be a good addition. Sunscreen would also be a wise addition. Bring your cameras. There is nothing more exciting than to capture the photo of someone with their prized catch-especially little ones!

Fishing and nature walks will follow. Kubb will be available, if you would like try this Norwegian game. I ask that all adults be prepared to supervise the young ones, especially at the shoreline, as the ground is uneven and the water is high.

Entries into the fisheree contest are \$2.00 per child or adult. Prizes will be awarded. See Cheryl when you arrive to be included in the fisheree registration.

<u>Provided:</u> private lake access (fishing from shoreline only), an opportunity to meet and greet others from Sons of Norway Lodges, a time to enjoy the great outdoors, fish, take a nature walk, and learn to play or enjoy a game of kubb, look for fawns, or bird watch

<u>What to Bring</u>: a dish to pass, a beverage of choice, lawn chairs, bug spray, a disposal bag for your refuse, fishing gear, bait, walking sticks, a camera, a hat, sunblock, a book or deck of cards, binoculars, other health or comfort items you require

<u>Dress for Conditions</u>: Comfortable attire and walking shoes needed; the ground is uneven.

<u>A Chance to Win:</u> Registration for the fishing contest will occur for *youth* and *adults, \$2.00 per person*.
