Submitting Your Photos to the District Happenings Section

Viking's District Happenings section is the perfect place to showcase your lodge. Here are some helpful guidelines for the submission process to get you started.

Send your photographs to your lodge publicity director who will forward them to your district publicity director. If your lodge does not have a lodge publicity director, please send submissions directly to the district publicity director via mail or email. Contact information for the district publicity directors can be found on the corresponding district page of Viking Magazine.

Each month, the district publicity director selects four of the best photos and submits them to Sons of Norway Headquarters so that they may be edited and sent to the magazine publisher. Since Viking is assembled two months in advance, please email photo submissions and caption information to ensure more timely publication. Emailed photo submissions should be sent as attachments. Photos may also be submitted in hard copy via postal mail as long as they reflect the same quality as professionally processed photos. Downloadable photo submission forms can be found in the member resources section of the Sons of Norway website, or they may be requested from your District Publicity Director.

Photo Criteria

- Digital photos must have a resolution of 300 dpi (dots per inch) or greater with no visible pixelation or blur and be at least 3"x 5" in physical size. High resolution images will always be a larger file size, often several hundred kilobytes (KB) or from one to 10 megabytes (MB) and up.
- Printed photos must be a minimum of 3"x 5" in physical size and reflect the same quality as professionally processed photos. There can be no visible ink dots, stripes or patterns in the image from the printing process. Please do not write caption information on the back of the photograph as the pen pressure can damage the print. Photos should be crisp and clear; a blurry or grainy photo cannot be used. If you are unsure about the quality of your print, email the original digital file to your district publicity director, as it is possible the digital file can be used instead.
- The photo must contain Sons of Norway members and caption information must relate directly to the content of the photograph.
- Photos of inanimate objects (handicrafts, food items, murals, etc.) will not be used.
- Photos must be visually interesting, well lit, and of good composition. It is best to avoid photos containing distracting items in the foreground.
- Composite or digitally altered images will not be used.

Come Along with Us; It's Ringsaker or Bust!

The District 5 Sports and Recreation Committee challenges all lodge members to participate in a virtual pilgrimage from the United States to Ringsaker, Norway-the site of the 2020 International Convention. Members may collect their miles through any form of sports activity: i.e., walking, running, snowshoeing, biking, skiing, or swimming. They may include mileage accumulated at one's health club, using the machines of their choice.

The challenge is designed to include your lodge's heritage and Unger Venner members, too. Youth practices, games, and tournament play will count toward any lodge total! Participants need to simply wear a pedometer or another such device to record any mileage. Parents may measure distances from any activity, if pedometers are not allowed.

Posted on the District 5 webpage are the forms each lodge will need to complete this challenge. The challenge begins on November 1, 2019 and will continue through June 15, 2020. Encourage your members to improve their fitness and work toward this goal.

We will celebrate the 125th anniversary of the founding of the Sons of Norway at the 2020 District 5 Convention by sharing some lodge photos in a slide presentation. For those not attending the Convention, the Power Point presentation will be posted on the District 5 webpage to be shown when appropriate.

We encourage local sports directors to check in with their athletes once a month to gather the mileage they have recorded. An optional activity would be to post a world map showing the progress your lodge members have made.

We hope that all Sons of Norway members will enjoy participating in the 2020 sports challenge. Lykke til-Good luck!

District 5 Sports and Recreation Challenge for the 2020 Convention

Join members from all over District Five as we celebrate the 125th anniversary of the founding of the Sons of Norway and support our youth heritage camp, Masse Moro! We are asking lodges to encourage their members to keep track of miles walked, run, swam, skied, or accumulated through other activities using a pedometer or like device. All ages can participate and be sure to include your heritage and Unge Venner members! Heritage (youth) members may wear pedometers during their practices, games, and tournaments to collect additional miles for their respective lodge.

The Challenge timeline is from November 1, 2019-June 15, 2020. The objective is to virtually track the miles from various sporting activities and go the distance from your lodge to Minneapolis, MN (where Sons of Norway was founded) and then to Ringsaker, Norway where the International Lodge Meeting and Convention will be held.

Lodges and members can use the tracking sheet to record the names of the lodge participants with space provided for activity and mileage. Participants may choose to find sponsors who will donate an amount per mile for their efforts, or a lodge may opt to give a donation on behalf of their athletes. Monies will be deposited into the *District 5 Nordic Legacy Foundation*, with the intent of providing funding to Masse Moro. A suggested minimum contribution of \$50.00 per lodge is encouraged.

*Lodge sports directors are encouraged to receive a monthly report from their participants that can be shared with their lodge members at a meeting or via a written communication, indicating how many miles have been recorded.

Lodges who complete the challenge will be recognized in the following ways:

- Lodge names and locations will be posted on the District 5 webpage.
- Lodges will receive a certificate suitable for framing in recognition of member efforts.
- Pictures of some active participants will be shared at the District 5 Convention in Madison, WI.
