
From our Youth Director -

Will SON start billing the families the new way, or will we have to make all those changes this year?

Of the three grandchildren ages 0 to 24, those who are Heritage members (0 to 15) will remain free regardless of where they live. Those 16 to 23 years old will receive bills on their anniversary date in 2018 with instructions about the family membership category. The family membership category is available to those who have the same mailing address in our system (college students qualify, even if they live elsewhere, if they use their family household mailing address). Unless the Unge Venner member resides with their grandmother, she would pay \$60 (unless she is a golden member before Jan 1, 2018) and the Unge Venner would pay \$60 for an individual membership or the family household would pay \$95.

Bills for 2018, with the new dues rates will be sent out starting on November 15 for those with an anniversary date of January 1 and after. We will follow our normal billing schedule, sending out bills based on 2018 anniversary dates. If 2 or more members in a household have different anniversary dates, we will use the latest date as the renewal date for the family.

We are not looking to lodges to change the address for family memberships. Members will receive information in their bills and can update their address when they renew their memberships.
