We are so excited to share the *Letters from Anne* program with you! Anne Engum was the daughter of Paul and Anne Engum, born in Norway on July 27, 1853. The Engum family emigrated to Coon Valley because the landscape was similar to that of Norway, with soil that was excellent for farming. They left Norway on April 12, 1867, on the Steamship "Rhea". The Engum House, which is now the centerpiece of the Historic Bekkum Homestead at Norskeden, began to be built in 1868. Anne's letters were developed based on examples found in "In Their Own Words: Letters from Norwegian Immigrants" by Solveig Zempel and "America-America Letters: A Norwegian-American Family Correspondence" by Bjorn Gunnar Ostgard.
