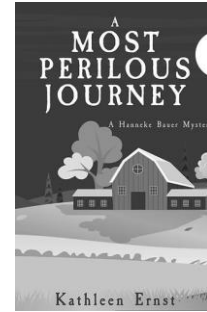

This richly illustrated program provides a tour of Hanneke's world: Wisconsin's Pomeranian community near Watertown. Often over-shadowed by the American Civil War, this period was marked by conflicts arising from anti-immigrant sentiments, slavery and abolition beliefs, and the trials inherent in making a new home in a new place. Kathleen Ernst is a social historian, educator, and bestselling author. Kathleen's forty-plus published books encompass mysteries, historical fiction, poetry, and non-fiction. *A Most Perilous Journey* is the most recent book in the Hanneke Bauer historical mystery series about a newly-arrived German immigrant.
