Preserving the Viking Ship of the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago

Please join us on Sunday, November 10 at 2 p.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church, downtown Kalamazoo, for our monthly lodge meeting. David Nordin, a Trustee of the Friends of the Viking Ship (FOVS), of the Greater Chicago area, will have a presentation about a Viking ship called the "Viking." Mr. Nordin's presentation will begin promptly at 2 p.m. Please plan accordingly.

This is a joint program with the Swedish-American Vasa Lodge. Please invite any friends that may be interested in Viking ships.

After Mr. Nordin's presentation, snacks will be served. (There will be no smorgasbord meal at this meeting.) **Askeladden members are welcome to bring finger foods to share.**

The "Viking" ship, constructed in the early 1890s in Norway, sailed from Norway to Chicago in 1893 for the World's Columbian Exposition. The Viking ship, currently housed in Geneva, Illinois, is an exact replica of the Gokstad, the ancient Viking ship, currently housed in the Viking Ship Hall in Oslo. Mr. Nordin will have two different books to offer to interested attendees. The cost for either book is a \$20 donation to the FOVS organization. One of the books was commissioned by FOVS and is a translation from the Norwegian original by Rasmus Rasmussen. Rasmussen, one of the actual 1893 Viking crew members who journeyed from Norway, tells of his adventures at sea and on shore as a member of the Viking crew with many rich details.

This November meeting is more than an opportunity to socialize with friends and to hear an interesting program on Viking ships. At this meeting, we ask Askeladden members to do something for the community by participating in a Food Drive and a Food Bank Campaign.
