Kvæfjordkake KVF-1 Wed Nov 17 @ 6pm CST, KVF-2 Fri Nov 19 @ 4pm CST, KVF-3 Sat, Dec 4 @ 10am CST. Ask any Norwegian, Kvæfjordkake and their eyes will light up. This cake has long been reserved for celebrations like birthdays, anniversaries, confirmations, baptisms, and holidays. This layered sponge cake is topped with meringue and almonds and filled with a vanilla custard cream. After one bite, you will see why this luxurious and dreamy cake is known as the Verdens beste... "world's best" cake.

Sandbakkel, Rosette, and Fattigmann. What am I doing wrong? **SRF-1** Sun, Nov 14 @ 1pm CST, **SRF-2** Tues Dec 7 @ 6pm CST. Do you find yourself chiseling out your Sandbakkel from the tin? Rosette will not drop off the iron? Fattigmann... how do I get the dough through the slit?...I will be sharing tips, tricks, and techniques to successfully make these cookies on your own.

Lussekatter (St Lucia Buns) LUS-1 Wed, Dec 8 @ 6pm CST, LUS-2 Sat Dec 11 @ 10am CST. Lussekatter traditionally kick off the holiday baking season in Norway and Sweden. These saffron buns are prepared in celebration on St Lucia Day, December 13, and served throughout Advent. In this class you will learn about the tradition behind the fluffy saffron yellow buns, why they are shaped like an "S" and/or Rams head, and why Norwegians and Swedes celebrate the Italian Saint Lucia.

Pavlova with Lemon Custard and Fresh Berries **PAV-1** Sun, Nov 21 @ 6p CST, **PAV-2** Tues, Dec 14 @ 6pm CST. Maximum class size: 12 participants. Come bake along with me. We will work through the steps of making this meringue-based dessert. We will talk about how you can store your Pavlova for a great quick dessert. *Recipe, baking equipment, and supply list will be emailed with the online invitation.

Scandinavian Almond Cake **SAC-1** Wed, Dec 1 @ 6pm CST, **SAC-2** Mon, Dec 20 @ 6pm CST. A longtime favorite with coffee, Scandinavian Almond Cake is one dessert you need to add to your holiday baking. I will be demonstrating how to make this traditional cake as well as its Gluten-free version. I often bake and freeze 3-4 cakes ahead of time.
