Serinakaker

Makes about 12 dozen

INGREDIENTS:

2 large eggs

1 cup sugar

4 cups all-purpose flour

1 tsp. baking powder

3 sticks salted butter, softened

1/2 cup pearl sugar, or coarsely crushed sugar cubes

STEP 1

Beat together 1 egg and sugar with an electric mixer until thick and pale. Sift in flour and baking powder and add butter. Beat on low speed until mixture forms a dough. Wrap in plastic wrap and chill until firm, at least 1 hour.

STEP 2:

Preheat oven to 350°F.

STEP 3:

Lightly beat remaining egg. Roll level teaspoons of dough into balls and arrange 1 inch apart on ungreased baking sheets. Press thumb into center of each ball to flatten, leaving a depression,

and brush lightly with egg. Sprinkle crushed sugar in centers and bake in batches in middle of oven until golden, 12 to 18 minutes. Transfer to racks to cool completely.


