"Who Were the Sloopers?"

Guest Speaker: Dave Johnson

Did you know that the first permanent Norwegian settlement in the United States was not in Minnesota or Wisconsin, but in Illinois? We'll Zoom into the New Year (literally) with an interesting presentation by Dave Johnson, of the Norsk Museum near Norway, IL.

The Norsk Museum (in the former Hauge Lutheran Church building) is on the Illinois Register of historic places as part of the first permanent Norwegian settlement in the United States. Dave Johnson is an author, genealogist and President of the Norsk Museum Board of Directors. He will share the story of the Sloopers, the Norwegians who sailed here 200 years ago aboard the Restauration slooper ship.

A Zoom link will be e-mailed before the meeting. After Mr. Johnson's presentation, we will have a short business meeting to swear in our new officers.
