Board of Directors Meetings Summary

Curtis Cleveland, Former President The Board of Directors met November 11 and December 15. Both meetings, each lasting one hour, were held at Trinity Lutheran Church on the same day as the lodge meeting.

Both meetings were devoted to establishing a program to retain young members in the lodge, previously known as Unge Venner members, ages 16 to 23 inclusively.

Background: At the October 7 Lodge meeting, the members, after discussion, agreed that the Lodge should adapt a program whereby members would be reimbursed a portion of their membership dues in order to retain the young members.

After much discussion, the Board approved a program whereby members who change their Individual membership to a Family membership, in order to retain a young member, will have the opportunity to be reimbursed \$49 of their membership dues.

The Board approved several donations, including: \$100 to the Kalamazoo Gospel Mission, \$100 to the Ministry with Community, \$100 to the Ski for Light, Inc (Minneapolis), and \$100 to the District 5 in support of the Barnebirkie.

Prior to the November and December meetings, the Board met in August, September, and October. At these meetings, several items were discussed, including the 2019 budget, 30th Anniversary Dinner, and the lodge meetings and events for the second half of 2018.

During the calendar year 2018, the Board of Directors met 7 times.

Long-time Lodge Member Passes Away in Iowa

We just learned that long-time Askeladden member Pat (Patricia) Askelson, passed away November 25, 2018, after battling cancer. Originally from Grand Forks, North Dakota, Pat joined the Sons of Norway in 1993. She remained a member of our lodge even after moving to Cedar Rapids, Iowa, many years

ago. She only gave up her membership a little more than a year ago after 24 years with the Sons of Norway. While they lived in the Kalamazoo area, the Askelson family housed a foreign exchange high school student, Per Morten Haarr, from Stavanger,



Norway, who also attended Lodge events. We hope Per returns to Kalamazoo some day for a visit.

Recap of the January 2019 Lodge Meeting

Curtis Cleveland, Cultural Committee Chair Defying the cold weather outside, many members and guests attended the January 13 Lodge meeting, held at Trinity Lutheran Church.

After a hearty meal, we viewed a video on the Draken Harald Hårfagre, the modern Viking longship. After the video, Joan talked about the financial and legal issues that the vessel faced when traveling on the US waterways and the Sons of Norway's involvement in raising funds for the ship to travel through four of the Great Lakes in 2016.

During the business session, several announcements were made. Joyce Hare of the Scholarship Committee informed members that March 15 is the deadline for submitting applications for the Askeladden Lodge Myrtle Beinhauer Scholarship. Joan O'Bryan discussed the upcoming March 16 St Patrick's Day Parade.

Curtis Cleveland informed members about resolutions discussed at the International Sons of Norway Convention held August 2018 in Minneapolis. The resolutions concerned the following topics: 1) The *Viking for Kids* publication; 2) Golden Member classification; and 3) elimination of Unge Venner members. During the discussion, several members made comments on these topics. The comments will be summarized in a letter to the editor of the *Viking* magazine.

Curtis Cleveland, the outgoing Lodge President, discussed the decline in the cash balance in the lodge's endowment fund, suggesting actions to curtail or slow the decline.

Joyce Hare installed the 2019 Lodge Officers.

Curt Osborn, the newly installed Lodge President, closed the meeting with Remarks for the Good of the Order.
