# **November 9th Event Recap- Restauration Celebration**

For our November meeting, lodge members gathered to continue the celebration of the Restauration replica ship's successful landing in New York City Harbor exactly one month before. Elizabeth Kraatz presented an interesting program of video highlights developed in collaboration with Gail Thompson-Hadley. We saw an interview with Slooper descendent and Vesterheim Museum volunteer Dale Goodman, and learned more about Slooper drama during their historic 1825 voyage. For examples, the Sloopers barely escaped arrest in Cornwall for violation of England's liquor laws. Cannon fire might have ended their voyage in Madeira, Portugal when they were mistaken for a plague ship after a little too much wine was imbibed from a surprise floating cask of wine (which was of course recovered from sharkinfested waters)! A baby girl was born during the voyage- I later learned she became a fellow suffragette with Susan B. Anthony.

Video clips of the Restauration's arrival in NYC, and the heartfelt speech by H.R.H. Crown Prince Haakon were



particularly festive. Did you know that Brooklyn once trailed only Oslo and Stavanger, Norway for number of Norwegian speakers?

At our business meeting afterward, the 2026 slate of Lodge officers and the 2026 budget were approved by unanimous vote.


## Eleven Members Bring "Love from Norway" to the Kalamazoo Holiday Parade
