

Karn's father, Bob Erlandson, came to us by Zoom and presented on a historical Norwegian figure, who held innovative ideas about the aurora and was also an inventor.

Kristian Birkeland discovered the basic mechanism of the aurora and advanced mankind's knowledge of the Earth's geomagnetic environment. Bob welcomed and answered all of our questions about Birkeland and his legacy. A business meeting followed, where our recently inducted officers posed for a photo.
