NORSO OSS - (NORWEGIAN SPECIAL OPERATIONS)

While Olav Eide's 99th Viking Battalion trained with the 10th Mountain Infantry Division in Camp Hale, Colorado where he was selected by the OSS (Office of Strategic Services-Intelligence, later named CIA) for future behind the line's covert operations in Norway. He was promoted to Sgt E-5, and trained first in Washington D.C., then in Scotland. In late June 1944, he parachuted with a small NORSO group named Percy Red into German-controlled France to work with the French resistance to disrupt German troop movement. After four weeks, his small group returned to England to prepare for covert assignments in Nazioccupied Norway in early 1945.

- There is no fee.
- Preregistration is needed.
- Work must have been finished after the last convention.
- Only SofN members may enter.
- Work must be completed by the person registered as the artist.
- Each item must have appropriate identification attached.
- Items will be kept in a locked room overnight.
- Volunteers will monitor the display during the day.

- Nordic or Sami-influenced knitting
- Norwegian needlework (Hardanger embroidery, Klostersøm, Diamantsom, Nålbinding)
- Crocheting
- Tatting
- Wood carving (figure, relief, chip carving)
- Bent wood construction
- Photography
- Painting
- Knifemaking
- Stained Glass
- Kolrosing

Cultural arts items may be checked in at the display area Thursday, June 20th between 1 pm and 3 pm.


Fosselyngen Lodge extends its sympathy to:
