# Upcoming Meeting Programs- Wednesdays at 7 PM

**July 10-** "The Viking Sword that Wasn't" -In 1911, a sword was dug up in the prairie of Minnesota near the town of Ulen. Not long after, it was declared a Viking-Age sword. But in 2007, that all changed. No longer deemed a Viking sword by most people in and around Ulen, this talk explores what happened and what it can tell us about Nordic-American life in the Upper Midwest. Marcus Cederström earned his B.A. from the University of Oregon in Sports Business, History, and Scandinavian Studies and his M.A. and Ph.D. in Scandinavian Studies and Folklore from the University of Wisconsin–Madison. He works in the Department of German, Nordic, and Slavic+ at UW–Madison as the community curator of Nordic-American folklore for the "Sustaining Scandinavian Folk Arts in the Upper Midwest" project. Cederström teaches folklore courses, conducts fieldwork with Nordic Americans throughout the Upper Midwest, and works with folklorists and artists throughout the region to create public programming supporting traditional folk arts.

**August 14-** "An Evening about the Hjemkomst Vikingship" - Recovering from a fall in 1971, Moorhead Minnesota Junior High School guidance counselor Robert Asp read a book on the Vikings. This sparked the thought that he should build and sail his own Viking ship. After eleven years of planning, building, and training, the ship named Hjemkomst sailed from Duluth, Minnesota, to Oslo, Norway. Tom Asp, son of Robert Asp, will present on the planning, building of the ship, learning how to sail, crew selection, and the Atlantic crossing.
