The District 5 Sports and Recreation Committee challenges all lodge members to participate in a virtual pilgrimage from the United States to Ringsaker, Norway-the site of the 2020 International Convention. Members may collect their miles through any form of sports activity: i.e., walking, running, snowshoeing, biking, skiing, or swimming. They may include mileage accumulated at one's health club, using the machines of their choice. Participants need to simply wear a pedometer, track their miles or minutes, or another such device to record any mileage. Parents may measure distances from any activity, if pedometers are not allowed.

Posted on the District 5 webpage are the forms each lodge will need to complete this challenge. The challenge begins on November 1, 2019 and will continue through December 15, 2020.

#### **Activities to Steps Conversion Chart**

To convert your activity time from minutes to steps, simply multiply the number of minutes you participated in the activity by the number indicated in the chart. Example: 30 minutes gardening x 131 steps/minute=3930 steps. **About 2000-2400 steps = 1 mile**, depending on the length of your stride. An average person has a stride length of about 2.1-2.5 feet.

#### SONS OF NORWAY- MANDT LODGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION-2020

This scholarship is open to any current members, their children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren who have been **SN Mandt Lodge members for a minimum of six months (dues paid and in good standing).** Members who are not parents may nominate nieces or nephews for the scholarship. An individual may only receive this scholarship one time. Scholarships are open to students pursuing associate degrees, technical school, college, university or graduate school. The application should be mailed to **Sons of Norway, 317 South Page Street, Stoughton, WI 53589 and postmarked by June 1, 2020.** Applications will be judged by the Lodge's Scholarship Committee and then approved by the Lodge officer's. Results will be announced in the Lodge newsletter and mailed to applicants. The applications are judged 40% scholastic, 30% activities, 20% need and 10% quality of the application. The scholarship money will be distributed to the winners at the January Lodge meeting after completion of the fall semester has been verified to Lodge officers. The scholarship will be a minimum of \$500 but can raised as determined by the Scholarship Committee. A minimum balance of \$250 must be kept in the Scholarship Fund.

#### So what's next as we move forward?
