District 5 Sons of Norway Convention 2022 Update

Date: June 15-19, 2022

Location: Madison Marriott West, 1313 John Q. Hammons Dr., Middleton, WI 53562

Room Rate: \$132 per night (2 queen beds, up to 4 people per room)

Hosted by Idun Lodge 5-074, Madison, WI

Lodges will be notified by mid-January as to how many delegates and alternates should be elected by March 5. Delegates do NOT have to be benefit members, but in order to run for a District Board position, alternate to the board, international delegate or alternate, they must be.

Other deadlines will be determined by the Idun Convention committee.
