Brief History - Sons of Norway Foundation

2020 Together We Are The Future (Together)

1. The 2020 Together fundraising campaign was approved by the Foundation Board of Governors (FBG) in August 2020. The campaign would coincide with SON Foundation Month - October.

2. FBG members Robin Fossum and Jon Tehven submitted a campaign business plan that the FBG approved.

3. The goal was to raise \$100,000: \$50,000 in advanced donations as a 'match' and another \$50,000 from lodges and members between September 1 and January 15.

4. The advance donations/pledges campaign began in early September and \$50,000 was raised/pledged by October 1. These donations were the result of phone calls to past major donors.

- 5. The Together campaign with a donation envelope was announced in the October Viking Magazine
- 6. Donors were allowed to decide how they wished their donations to be used.
- 7. The 2020 Together campaign exceeded all expectations:

A. As of January 13, 2021:

- a. A total of \$210,164 has been donated.
- b. 837 donations were received, 113 were from lodges.
- c. SON lodges donated \$29,585.
- d. There was an undesignated \$20,000 memorial.

8. 2021 Together goals

Promote SON Foundation throughout the six (6) USA districts to raise funds for the Foundation.

- A. 2021 Foundation Goal: Raise \$231,780 from January 2021 January 15, 2022
 - a. This goal is donations from lodges and members
- B. 2021 Together campaign goals: raise \$150,000
 - a. This goal does NOT include major gifts defined as \$20,000+
 - The time is extended to January 15, 2022 to allow for IRA contributions
- C. Match goal donations and pledges
 - a. \$60,000 between September 1 September 30
 - b. This includes donations received and commitments
- D. October January 15 donations and pledges
 - a. Raise \$90,000 from lodges and members
- E. Audience: Sons of Norway members and others as identified:
 - a. Individual members
 - b. Lodges
 - c. Leadership, as identified:
 - Foundation Board of Governors
 - International Board of Directors
 - District Foundation Directors
 - District Presidents
 - District Boards of Directors
 - Past International, Foundation, and District leadership
 - Lodge Officers
 - HQ Leadership
 - d. Other
