# **Cultural Challenge!**

Cultural Committee Challenge to D5 Members

Leading up to the 2026 District 5 Convention, the District 5 Cultural Committee gives all District 5 members this challenge:

Try some new Norwegian cultural skill that you've <u>never done before</u>. Complete any one Sons of Norway Cultural Skills project completed between May 1st 2025 and May 1st 2026. You would be eligible for a Cultural Skills pin from your local Sons of Norway lodge and after completing this challenge, this member would also be recognized by District 5 and receive a token of appreciation. Each member needs to send the Cultural Committee Chair, Lucy Ghastin, proof that all aspects of a particular cultural skill level were completed. There is no need to send the whole project. An officer of your lodge (usually the Cultural Director) would sign the paper, and the member would sign. ## **Cultural Program Overview**

- Each unit consists of three levels of skill-specific activities that can be completed on your own, or as part of a lodge group or class.
- For each level, you'll complete a few activities, submit them to your lodge Cultural Director, and have the option to order a pin in recognition of your accomplishments.
- When you complete part 1 of your first unit your lodge Cultural Director may order you a
  Cultural Skills pin, a skill bar and a level 1 bar. When you complete parts 2 and 3 of that
  skill, or level 1 of a new skill, your Cultural Director may order the additional bars.

#### Go Further with Your Cultural Skills

Want to take your skills to a new level? Members who have completed multiple units or mentored others in the program can earn special recognition:


A Master of Cultural Skills is someone who has completed multiple units. Finish all three parts of any three units for the bronze level, all parts of six units for the silver level and all parts of nine units for the gold level.

A Cultural Skills Mentor earns his/her Mentor Pin by assisting others in a given activity: five members for Part one, three members for Part two and one member for Part three. Note that these members must show the Cultural Director their reports for the mentor to be awarded the Mentor Pin. (download the Mentor Tracking Report pdf form)
