Both Sons of Norway Headquarters and your district secretary are able to access your information from the website.

- No Changes? Please still visit the Officer Update section on our website and confirm the no changes option.
- <u>Deadline December 31st:</u> Timely reporting of this information to Fraternal assures that your lodge's information will be correct in the Sons of Norway Headquarters database and in the online directory. Also, lodges meeting this deadline will score points towards the Lodge of the Year and Gold/Silver/Bronze merit awards.

If the deadline is approaching and your lodge hasn't reported its new officer roster, please submit the information you have and/or contact Fraternal. Changes made after the 12/31 deadline should still be reported, though these updates may not be reflected in the new district directories.

# Officer Updates Online

## To Update Your Officer Roster:

Sign on to www.sofn.com with your username and password.

Click "Lodge Officer Updates" on the menu to the left of your name on your Profile Page.

To register your 2025 Officer Roster, click on the "Officers" button.

- No changes? Click the "No Changes for Upcoming Year" button at the top of the page.
- Adding a completely new officer position in 2025? Click "Add a new position" and then enter the title and member number of the person filling the office. Hit "Submit." Then hit "Save the Changes."
- To record a change in officer, delete the member number of the outgoing officer and type in the member number of the incoming officer. (The names will NOT change on the screen at this point.)
- If your lodge is **eliminating a position**, click the "Remove this position" button for that entry.
- Once you have made ALL your changes, click the "SUBMIT CHANGES" button at the bottom of the page.
- You will see a list of your changes. If they are correct, click "Save the Changes." Both Sons of Norway Headquarters and the District Secretary will receive a notification email.
- Your 2025 roster of officers has been recorded!

- Click the "Change Meeting Information" button.
- Make your changes and click the "Save" button.

#### **Our Mission**

The mission of the Sons of Norway Foundation is to celebrate Nordic culture and heritage through scholarships and grants to our members and communities.

# Grant Background

The Community Partnership Grant is funded through the Heritage and Culture Fund which was established in 1987. This fund was initially supported by Her Majesty Queen Sonja of Norway who lent her name to an early fund-raising effort. The Crown Princess Sonja pendant was issued in sterling silver and gold and was awarded to individuals or lodges who support this fund according to certain specifications. The number of grants awarded from this fund has increased through the years due to the continued support of our generous members and friends.

#### Maximum Award

The maximum award is \$5,000.

## Eligible Applicants

This grant is open to individuals or groups from Norway and the United States who wish to share their Norwegian heritage and culture through the project for which they apply for funding.

#### Eligible Projects

Projects that promote and preserve the culture and heritage of Norway are eligible. Examples of previously funded projects are cultural classes or presentations, documentation of local cultural history, hosting of visiting performing groups, etc.

#### Timeline

Applications must be for programs or projects that take place between January 2025 - March 2026.

#### **Applications**

All applications for Community Partnership Grant must be written in English and be submitted online at our website, <a href="www.sonsofnorway.com/foundation/grants">www.sonsofnorway.com/foundation/grants</a>. Paper applications will NOT be accepted.

Each application must include:

- a narrative statement of 500 words or less that summarizes the importance of the project,
- · a completed budget that states the exact dollar amount requested,
- the contact information of the person making the request,
- · two letters in support of the project,
- the payable information including an address to send payment if an award is granted.

Please provide email addresses for two different people to write a letter in support of your project. They will receive a link to provide this letter online along with instructions from the Foundation via email.
