Nordic News this week...

Marlene Wisuri of the **North American Sami Center** gave us an understanding of Sami culture with **Putting Up The Lavvu at the Sami Cultural Center** on *Nordic News* on Tuesday Feb. 23. The Sami is northern Scandinavia's native people. Over 30,000 Sami immigrated to the United States, and most assimilated completely into Norwegian-American communities. Some Sami were hired to teach reindeer herders by the U.S. government to teach this skill to Alaska native tribes in the late 1800s. Duluth Minnesota's North American Sami Center has a collection of Sami artifacts, including these carved reindeer bone knives.



In this week's video, Sherry Gorse of Membership Services walks through the step-by-step process of filling out the D17 form, our annually required lodge financial disclosure form.

Sherry Gorse of Membership Services explains how to complete the D17 form

<u>Local Lodge Financial Statement (D17) and IRS Form 990</u> <u>https://www.sofn.com/blog/local-lodge-financial-statement-d17-</u> and-irs-form-990/

Every year, each lodge is required to file two financial forms. These are the Local Lodge Financial Statement (Form D17) and the IRS Form 990.

Lodges that own property also must complete the Local Lodge Property Financial Statement (D18)

<u>The Local Lodge Financial Statement (Form D17) : due date March 15, 2021</u>

To access and complete the D17 online (preferred method):

- Log on to <u>sofn.com</u>.
- The landing page will be the Member Profile Page.
- Click the "Lodge D17 List" link, which is to the left of the name and address.
- Click "Edit" at the top of the list of D17s, for Period End 12/31/2020.
- Enter the totals in the appropriate fields.

- Click the 'Continue' button at the bottom of the form
- If you are finished and ready to approve the D17, click "Approve" near the end of the line.
- Type your member number in the appropriate field at the bottom of the page.
- Click "Submit My Approval."
- Enter your Lodge President's email address (it may already be filled in) to send it for his/her signature.
- Click "Send Notice."
- Click "Return to my Member Profile Page."

A PDF version of the D17 form can be downloaded from the Lodge Forms section via Membership Services/Lodge Leadership Resources/Administrative Resources. Completed paper forms should be mailed to Sons of Norway, 1455 West Lake Street, Minneapolis, MN 55408. Due date is March 15, 2021.

IRS Form 990 (this includes the 990, the 990EZ and the 990N): must be filed by May 15, 2021

The IRS requires all Sons of Norway lodges to file a 990 form:

- For lodges with less than \$50,000 in gross receipts, a 990-N (e-Postcard) must be filed electronically via the IRS.gov website. More information and the link to the "Form 990-N Electronic Filing System (e-Postcard)" can be found here: <u>https://www.irs.gov/charities-non-profits/annual-electronic-filing-requirement-for-small-exempt-organizations-form-990-n-e-postcard</u>
- For lodges with gross receipts in excess of \$50,000 a form 990EZ or form 990 must be filed.

Directions for filing the 990s can be accessed on the IRS website, or the lodge may choose to utilize the services of a tax preparer to complete and file the forms.

Once your 990 filing is complete (either the 990 form itself or an extension), please notify Sons of Norway headquarters by sending an email to <u>taxinfo@sofn.com</u> or by calling Sherry Gorse at 612-821-4643.

It is imperative that you file this important tax form by May 15. Failure to file could result in an automatic loss of tax-exempt status for your lodge.

Sons of Norway takes this compliance very seriously. We have learned that it can be a very costly and time-consuming experience for a lodge to lose its tax-exempt status, and non-compliance of these reports could jeopardize the tax exempt status of the entire organization

The Local Lodge Property Financial Statement (Form D18): March 15

Lodges with a Property Association must also file a D18 form. It can be accessed on <u>sofn.com</u> and is very similar to the D17 form. Please contact Sherry Gorse at <u>fraternal@sofn.com</u> or 612-8214643 with any questions.

Important Note:

The Board of Directors has implemented procedures to encourage 100% compliance in the filing of the D17s, 990s and D18s, including withholding local and district dues, and potential revocation of a lodge's charter.

Golden Membership Procedures for 2021

Sons of Norway Headquarters will be sending out one more Golden Membership mailing to Lodge Presidents for people who became Golden in the last quarter of 2020. This will be the last automatic mailing of Golden Certificates and Pins to lodges.

Determining New Golden Members in 2021

Lodge Officers can use the lodge Monthly Activity Report and Membership Lists to assess who has attained/will attain Golden Membership throughout the year. Golden Membership is awarded to members who are age 65 or older and have been members for 30 years or more.

Sons of Norway Lodge Membership Activity Report

This report is generated at the beginning of every month. It is automatically emailed or mailed to all lodge Vice Presidents, Financial Secretaries and Membership Secretaries. These officers (along with the President and a few other officers) can also access PDFs these reports through their profile page after signing on to <u>sofn.com</u>. When a lodge member reaches Golden status, they are listed under the heading **New Golden Members** on the next monthly report.

• Sons of Norway Lodge Membership Lists Lodge officers can download PDF or Excel versions of their membership lists from their profile page after signing on to <u>sofn.com</u>.

- To see who might be nearing their 30th anniversary with Sons of Norway, sort the Excel list by members' effective dates. Then, check those members' birthdates to see if will be 65 years or older on their anniversary date.
- Similarly, you can also sort the Excel list by age to see who is turning 65 this year. You would then check to see if they have also hit the 30-year anniversary threshold, in which case they will be eligible for Golden Status this year.
- DF lists sorted by effective date or age can be requested from Membership Services. **Personalizing and Printing Golden Certificates**

Lodge Presidents and other officers can now download, personalize and print out the special certificates for members attaining Golden Membership Status. They can be found on <u>sofn.com</u>:

- Sign in with your username and password.
- Click on the Member Resource button on top of page.
- Click on Lodge Leadership.
- Click on Administrative Resources.
- Click on View Lodge Forms.
- Scroll down to Certificates and click on Golden Membership.
- You can change the member name, lodge name and lodge number as well as the date.
- Print your personalized certificate. They look great in color or black and white.

Ordering Pins

Golden Member pins can still be ordered from Membership Services on as as-needed basis, and will remain free of charge.



Order Lodge Supplies Online

Sons of Norway recently implemented a new, streamlined process for ordering supplies. This change applies to most supply orders, including Sports Medals and Cultural Skills pins, as well as general lodge supplies like table flags, placemats and napkins.

These supplies can now be easily ordered directly through our online lodge supply store. To order your supplies, simply head over to <u>https://sofnlodge.logoshop.com/</u>. You can also find this link in your member profile after logging in at sofn.com. (This link is ONLY for lodge supply items and is not the same as the public online store for general Sons of Norway merchandise.)



Once you're in the lodge supply store, select 'Products' from the main navigation bar. This will bring you to a listing of all items that are available for ordering. Select the item(s) you wish to order by clicking on the name or image. Items like pins are grouped by type. For example, the gangmerke pins (bronze, silver, gold and enamel) are all grouped together.
