

- Applicant must be a full-time college student or a high school senior, with a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average (GPA) or better, who plans to attend or is attending an accredited post-secondary school (college, university, community college, or technical school).
- 2. Applicant, or their parent, grandparent, aunt or uncle must be a policy* or benefit member of a District 5 Lodge.
 - a. Sons of Norway benefits or policy include: an investment, insurance and/or annuity.
 - b. Member's policy must have been in effect for a minimum of one calendar year prior to this application.

 - describe your knowledge of your Norwegian heritage and how has this influenced your life.
