The Sons of Norway District 5 Norwegian-American virtual history course, **Norwegian-American Settlement in IL, MI and WI** will start with sessions offered on Saturday, January 23 (9:00-10:30 AM CT/10:00-11:30 ET) and Monday, January 25 (6:30-8:00 PM CT/7:30-9:00 PM ET). The course will be 16 weeks long.

- Weeks 1-3 will be an intensive overview of Norwegian-American history.
- Weeks 4-10 will cover frontier settlement history in Michigan, Illinois, Indiana and Wisconsin.
- Weeks 11-12 will be a "book club" format, where we will explore one of the best historical fiction books depicting Norwegian-American life.
- Week 13 will be dedicated exclusively to the Norwegian-American history of Michigan
- Week 14 will focus on special topics of interest in Norwegian-American history, such as inventors and interesting individuals.
- Weeks 15-16 will allow participants who choose to do a project an opportunity to make a presentation on their work.

Re: Local Lodge Financial Statement (D17) 990 Filing Information Local Lodge Property Financial Statement (D18)

Every year, each lodge is required to file two financial forms. These are the Local Lodge Financial Statement (Form D17) and the IRS Form 990.

Lodges who own property also must complete the Local Lodge Property Financial Statement (D18)

The Local Lodge Financial Statement (Form D17) : due date March 15, 2021

To access and complete the D17 online (preferred method):

- Log on to <u>www.sofn.com</u>.
- The landing page will be the Member Profile Page
- Click the "Lodge D17 List" link, which is to the left of the name and address.
- Click 'Edit' at the beginning of top of the list of D17s, for Period End 12/31/2020
- Enter the totals in the appropriate fields.
- Click 'Continue' button at the bottom of the form
- If finished and ready to approve the D17, click 'approve' near the end of the line.
- Type your member number in the appropriate field at the bottom of the page.
- Click 'Submit My Approval"
- Enter your Lodge President's email address (it may already be filled in) to send it for his/her signature.
- Click "Send Notice"
- Click "Return to my Member Profile Page"

A PDF version of the D17 form can be downloaded from the Lodge Forms section via Membership Services/Lodge Leadership Resources/Administrative Resources. Completed paper forms should be mailed to Sons of Norway, 1455 West Lake Street, Minneapolis, MN 55408. Due date is 03/15/2021.

IRS Form 990 (this includes the 990, the 990EZ and the 990N): required to be filed by May 15,

<u>2021</u>

The IRS requires all Sons of Norway lodges to file a 990 form:

- For lodges with less than \$50,000 in gross receipts a 990-N (e-Postcard) must be filed electronically via the IRS.gov website. More information and the link to the "Form 990-N Electronic Filing System (e-Postcard)" can be <u>found online</u>.
- For lodges with gross receipts in excess of \$50,000 a form 990EZ or form 990 must be filed.

Directions for filing the 990s can be accessed on the IRS website, or the lodge may choose to utilize the services of a tax preparer to complete and file the forms.

Once your 990 filing is complete (of the form itself or for an extension), please notify Sons of Norway Headquarters by sending an email to <u>taxinfo@sofn.com</u> or by calling Sherry Gorse at 612-821-4643.

It is imperative that you file this important tax form by May 15. Failure to file could result in an automatic loss of tax-exempt status for your lodge.

Sons of Norway takes this compliance very seriously. We have learned that it can be a very costly and time-consuming experience for a lodge to lose its tax-exempt status, and non-compliance of these reports could jeopardize the tax exempt status of the entire organization

The Local Lodge Property Financial Statement (Form D18) : March 15th

Lodges with a Property Association must also file a D18 form. It can be accessed on <u>www.sofn.com</u> and is very similar to the D17 form. Please contact Sherry Gorse at <u>fraternal@sofn.com</u> or 612-8214643 with any questions.

Important Note:

The Board of Directors has implemented procedures to encourage 100% compliance in the filling of the D17s, 990s and D18s, including withholding local and district dues, and the revocation of a lodge's charter.

Thank you for your attention to this important yearly procedure.
