Her sister Lucy Ghastin was also instrumental in the convention's success; her expertise in planning conventions kept all aspects on an even keel and progressing forward.

Especially appreciated was the work done by the many committees I appointed earlier this spring. Those who served on the nominations, credentials, laws, finance, publicity, resolutions, and fraternal affairs committees devoted more of their personal time to the convention and traveled to Indy earlier to complete this work in advance of the meeting.
