ADULT HERITAGE WEEKEND UPDATE

An appointment with the curatorial staff to see the holdings in the Bauder-Lansgard Collections Center at the Vesterheim Norwegian American Museum in Decorah, IA, has been secured for Sunday, October 9, 2022. Decorah is a short thirty-five-minute drive from Spring Grove, MN.

Laurann Gilbertson, Chief Curator, will be our guide. The participants will break into groups of ten to protect the climate-controlled atmosphere and allow everyone to see. An extra \$4 per person is charged to view this collection. Vesterheim's admission fees are \$10-adults/ \$8-seniors/\$2-youth per day tour rates. Museum members will waive the general admission price, but they would still pay the \$4.

Vesterheim's Main Building and Museum Store are open daily from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Those who do not wish to view the special collections can enjoy all of the holdings in the main museum.
