Delegate Election Information was due yesterday!

Hotel reservations can be made already as the information has been on the District website. I will also give President Johnsen the delegate and he will be selecting his committees. As soon as I get the lists from him, I'll send out the committee invitations.

Please note for both resolutions, bylaws, and convention bids: The due date is April 1. I must HAVE them in hand by then as the District Board meetings April 3-4 and I need to get them out to the board so they can review them before the meeting. We also need to do a site visit at the proposed hotel if it's one we're not familiar with. So please don't wait until the last week to be sending these to me! I am also out-of-state for work from that Friday, March 27-April 1 so ideally it would be great to have those before I leave.

Is your lodge sending in any resolutions or bylaws?

Your lodge may wish to propose <u>resolutions or by-law changes</u> to be considered at the District or International Conventions. These resolutions, along with <u>any proposed changes to the District 5 By-Laws or International Constitution</u>, <u>must be submitted to the District Secretary no later than April 1, 2020</u>. Please note that we are using the new template approved and recommended by the International Board.

Is your lodge going to submit a bid to host the 2022 District Convention?

If your lodge is interested in <u>hosting the 2022 District Lodge Meeting</u>, you are asked to send a written notice of your intention to the District Secretary <u>prior to April 1, 2020</u>. Should your lodge wish to present a bid, we ask that you make arrangements for a "walk through" of the facilities by a District 5 Board Member. This should be done prior to the June convention in order to identify proposal merits as well as needed additions or changes.


