

Lodge Liability Insurance for 2022/2023

Each year, Sons of Norway lodges with over 25 members receive a bill to help pay for the upcoming year's liability insurance for lodges and districts. These bills are sent in the mail to lodge Treasurers and are typically due in late September or early October.

This year, there has been a delay in getting these bills out to lodges. It is important to note that our lodges are currently covered by the new policy, even though they have yet to receive a bill.

Reaching Lodge Support

When a member or lodge officer calls Sons of Norway at 1-800-945-8851, they are given several options in order to be directed to the appropriate department.

- Option #1 Customer Service Members should choose #1 when they have questions about their dues payments, address changes or other questions about their membership. Customer Service also helps with issues relating to individual life insurance policies and annuities.
- Options #2 through #5 These are options for agents to call with questions about sales and commissions.
- Option #6 Lodge Support This is the important option for lodge officers. Lodge Support
 answers questions about lodge programming, such as Cultural Skills, Sports Medals
 and Lodge Deposit Funds. They administrate the different campaigns throughout the
 year: D63 Lodge Officer Updates, Lodge of the Year, D17 Financial Statements and
 more. We can also help with policies and procedures at the lodge level. Lodge Officers

Lodge Officer Updates Due December 31, 2022

It's time to report them to Sons of Norway Headquarters with your officer list for 2023.

Once a lodge has held its election in November (or if you don't elect this year, it still needs to be submitted!), the lodge secretary should document the changes (or lack of changes) via their profile page on <u>sofn.com</u>:

- 1. Sign on to sofn.com with your Username and Password
- 2. Click Lodge Officer Updates
- 3. Click Change Meeting Information if the location or time of your meetings will change for 2023
- 4. Click Officers to change your officer roster. You will need member numbers for new people taking over offices in 2023
- 5. If you have no changes, click No Changes for Upcoming Year
- 6. If you are adding a new officer position, for example if you didn't have a Youth Director in 2022 but WILL have a Youth Director in 2023, click Add a New Position. Then choose the title and add the member number for the person taking on the new office. Click Submit. Then click, Save the Changes
- 7. If you are removing a position for 2023, click the box Remove this Position under the title of the office
- 8. To record the new member holding an officer for 2023, type their member number in the Officer Member No. box. Add all the new officers before going to the next step. The names will NOT change on the screen in front of you
- 9. Click SUBMIT CHANGES
- 10. Click Save the Changes

The new changes will not go into effect until 01/15/2023. If you need to make changes that will go in place immediately, please contact Sons of Norway Headquarters.

Hei, hei, allesammen,

This week Duane Kittleson from Vennelag Lodge in Mt. Horeb, WI, was installed as a member of the Sons of Norway International Board of Directors (IBOD). His 25 years of insurance experience are a plus for the board and for the Fifth District. Former SofN president Jon Tehven was the officiating officer.

The district presidents also met and discussed a variety of topics. Numerous home office staff presented updates from their departments. Each district president shared the pros and cons of its operations since their district conventions this past summer. Connie O'Brien advised the group.

A troublesome bit of news came this week when the international office shared that numerous lodges in our district were in non-compliance and had not submitted their IRS 990 forms and/or the D17 lodge financial statements. I have contacted some of these lodges and discovered that some had indeed submitted their reporting. The way these forms are tracked at the international office is not adequate, and the reporting of the receipt of lodge IRS990 forms lacks accuracy on the IRS website.

There are additional presidents who will be receiving a call this week. If your lodge neglected to file these documents during the COVID-19 pandemic, please do so. Failure to do so will cause a series of events to occur and it could lead to the loss of your lodge's charter. The non-compliance could also affect the tax-exempt status of the international organization.

If you are a lodge president, mark March 1 for filing the D17 form and May 1 for submitting the IRS990 document. There is no need to wait, you may file ahead of these suggested dates! Remember to have your audit committee members sign the D17 document.

All of the 8 districts are grappling with recent cost-saving measures handed down from the IBOD which will directly affect our operations. In the event that you missed a recent announcement, <u>each</u> district will no longer receive the dues from Central Lodge members. The Central Lodge is our largest lodge. An approximation of the loss is \$2,000 per month. It will be necessary to further tighten our belts as we deal with this news.

The IT Dept. is ready to roll out its geo-tracking software that will show where lodges are located in each district. Hopefully, prospective members will find this tool helpful when searching for a lodge to call home.

With Tubfrim no longer being a viable depository for stamps, the international office offered an alternative. Richard and Christina Fairchild, our webmasters are investigating additional groups that could benefit from our stamps. Mary Benett shared that she will process all of the stamps she has received thus far. She made known that the district president is in charge of the stamp program. She and I will discuss the options when I return home at the end of the week. District 5 will be responsible for delivering or shipping our stamps to the receiving entity.

I am thrilled to report that all of our board positions are nearly full! We will hold a Zoom meeting to install new directors and proceed with the business of the district. To those who stepped up with your willingness to serve, thank you very much. Announcements of these servant leaders will be made following successful vetting.
