## Lutefisk dinner season ahead and the calls are coming!




If your lodge has a lutefisk dinner or there are ones in your area, please send me the information so we can share it.

#### Hello District 5 Leaders,

Below please find the latest lodge membership recruitment and retention numbers from the headquarters in Minneapolis. It is food for thought as we enter a new lodge year with some of our lodges.

It is also with sadness that I announce the closing of Vakkertland Lodge in Wisconsin Dells. Membership recruitment and retention is the lifeblood of any lodge's existence. Lodge presidents are the face of your group in their community, and they are responsible for its viability. Covid-19 has posed immeasurable challenges for 2020 and into 2021, but enrolling new members is possible!

Ask your current membership to take the satisfaction survey provided on the <a href="www.SofN.com">www.SofN.com</a> website or create a more appropriate one for your members. Please share with your Board what the membership has enjoyed and also indicate their concerns. How will your Board work to address any issues? Are your members friendly? New members want to be part of an energetic group with a positive attitude. They want to help with community service projects, especially those newly retired who want a focus. For example, do you work with children at a local school? If so, how do your efforts make their lives better? Do you have a working relationship with another not-for-profit group?

When does your lodge have fun together <u>without working</u>? Do you provide options for the arts? Travel? Cultural challenges? Exercise? Nordic museum options? Genealogy? How has your lodge thanked your members for their continued support? Appreciated members will proudly contribute more to your mission, and they will promote the lodge for you!

Identify your current community service projects, and don't forget to put your name out into the community! Simple things like a bake sale, a blood drive, a food collection, a clothing drive, or holiday gifting are all possibilities. Use the free press whenever possible, but paying for a small ad could reap the rewards. Facebook provides an option for a virtual presence. Some lodges also have accounts on Twitter and Instagram. Snapchat is another place to post the happenings of an event. Does your lodge have a website? For those of you who are trying to attract younger members, remember that those individuals seek a virtual site first!

What kind of programming do you offer? Is the programming varied? Have you visited other lodges to see what they are doing? Which speakers have proven effective and entertaining? Have you opted for the arts as presentations? Do you pair with another lodge to defray the cost? Are you aware that the District 5 website: <a href="www.sonsofnorway5.com">www.sonsofnorway5.com</a> has a Speakers' Bureau listing possible presenters, as well as the Nordic News programs? Is there someone in your community who has accomplished a stellar task? Invite them to speak to your members.

If you have not done so already, form a cultural committee to plan activities and events for 2021-2022. Locally posting your upcoming events brings interest from others. Think of venues where most people visit: the library, a grocery store, banks, fitness centers, local restaurants, gas stations, community centers, the Chamber of Commerce office, and community bulletin boards around your city or town.

Your lodge's social director and cultural director could work in tandem to plan some great options for your members. Invite your vice president or membership secretary to sit on this committee. 

## Viking Dog: The Norwegian Elkhound

Norway's national dog, the Norsk elghund (Norwegian Elkhound or more accurately "moose dog") is a medium-sized dog that has hunted, herded and played guard dog since Viking times. This ancient Spitz is one of the oldest dog breeds, having originated as early as 5,000 B.C. Elkhounds have been found buried at Viking grave sites such as the Svarthola in Jæren, Norway. According to DNA research, the elkhound is descended from an extinct type of gray wolf originating in western Russia and central Europe.
